
## World Cycling Championship for Seniors

'Road Worlds for Seniors' is the only global indoor cycling championship for seniors and people with dementia. Each year, thousands of cyclists from nursing homes, day care centers and senior centers participate in these global indoor cycling events.

This year, residents at our Chinook Care Centre competed in one of the largest global indoor sporting events for seniors! The event (titled: 'World Cycling Championship for Seniors') took place between October 7 - November 1, 2024 and involved 6,913 cyclists from ten (10) different countries across the globe! 72 of the 6,913 cyclists participating in this event were residents from our very own Chinook Care Center!

We are thrilled to report that Chinook Care Centre's resident cycling team ranked third (3rd) in Canada and eight (8th) overall globally, out of 150 teams!

Quality improvement projects allow clinicians, working within a team, to identify an issue and implement interventions that can result in true improvements in quality. Intercare's Directors of Care (DOCs) and Clinical Team Leaders (CTLs) lead quality improvement projects at their respective sites, based upon resident needs at each of the sites. This Newsletter will highlight and detail those projects.

# Brentwood Care Centre Quality Projects

#### Long Term Care

- ♥ Decrease the number pressure ulcers by 25%.
- ♥ Prevent aggressive incidents by decreasing repetitive aggressive behaviours.
- ▼ Improve Health Care Aides' (HCAs') understanding of Point of Care (POC) documentation and, through that, improve accuracy of POC documentation.
- ♥ Decrease the number of resident falls by 25%

#### Behavioral Support Unit (BSU)

♥ Decrease the incidence of missed documentation and documentation errors by staff by 50% over the next twelve (12) months.

## Chinook Care Centre Quality Projects

#### Long Term Care

- ♥ Decrease number of resident falls (falls without injury) by 25%.
- ♥ Reduce the number of resident falls by 15% in the next 3 months and by 20% in the 4th month.
- ♥ Reduce resident falls by 50% (focusing on evening shifts).
- ♥ Reduce use of chemical restraints by 10%.

#### Complex Dementia Care (CDC) Unit

Decrease the number of fall incidences (target group: repeat fallers).

#### Hospice

Improve and maximize skin health for End of Life (EOL) Hospice patients.

# Southwood Care Centre Quality Projects

### Long Term Care

- ♥ Work with attending physicians to complete overdue and upcoming physician assessments.
- ♥ Improve documentation on aggressive incident tracking sheets to ensure all behaviours are documented.
- ♥ Keep number of falls at 10 or less per month on the Bonavista Unit.
- Decrease number of resident falls by at least 50% (target group: non-repeat fallers).

#### Special Care Unit

Monthly Maintenance Record (Monthly Summary Assessment) to be completed for all residents on chemical restraint / antipsychotics.

#### **Hospice**

▼ Improve HCA compliance with the signing of Medication Administration Records (MARs) by 50% over the next 9 months.
